We are delighted to welcome **Dr. Fenil Kalaria**, Associate Consultant Intensivist & ICU Registrar (MBBS, E. MD, CT/IDCCM), to the Aashka Hospital Family.

▲ 1B: Excellence in Action

A 38-year-old man from Himmatnagar suffered a **severe crush injury** to his right hand while working on a conveyor belt machine. Referred to Aashka Hospital, he was promptly assessed by **Dr. Jaydeep Kansara** (Orthopaedic Surgeon) and **Dr. Sohil Shah** (Plastic Surgeon). **Heavy bleeding and an absent radial pulse** led to an urgent CT Angio, revealing extensive vascular damage that risked amputation.

The surgical team, including anesthetists and OT staff, swiftly prepared for a **complex vascular surgery, which began at 1:00 AM and concluded at 8:00 AM**. Remarkably, within hours post-surgery, pulsation returned to the patient's arm, signaling hope. After a few days of intensive ICU care and close monitoring, the patient recovered well, eventually **shifting to a room with strong pulsation and no fever**.

Today, he smiles with immense gratitude, thanking **Dr. Sohil Shah, Dr. Jaydeep Kansara, and the entire Aashka Hospital team for saving his arm** and making him whole again.





Winter Challenges for Bone & Joint Health By Dr. Jaydeep Kansara, MS (Orthopedics)

Common Challenges:

Stiffness & Injury Risk: Cold weather stiffens joints and muscles, reducing flexibility.

Worsening Pain: Conditions like osteoarthritis, gout, and rheumatoid arthritis flare up due to:

- ▲ Muscle spasms
- ▲ Reduced blood circulation
- ▲ Atmospheric pressure drop
- ▲ Increased pain sensitivity
- ▲ Low vitamin D from limited sunlight

Back Pain

Slips & Falls: Increased risk of fractures and soft tissue injuries.

Prevention Tips:

- ▲ Wear warm clothing and maintain indoor warmth.
- ▲ Stay active with stretching, yoga, walking, or aerobics.
- ▲ Maintain a healthy weight; avoid junk food.
- ▲ Sit with proper posture.
- ▲ Diet: Include calcium-rich foods, green veggies, dairy, and vitamin K and magnesium-rich options.
- ▲ Get adequate sunlight exposure.
- ▲ Stay hydrated with water, herbal teas, or hydrating beverages.
- ▲ Warm up before outdoor activities or exercise to prevent injuries.
- ▲ Wear footwear with good grip to avoid slips.
